Prerequisites: Attendance of the BIM for beginners or the transition to BS EN19650 series course.

Course Outline: Developed for designers and contractors who need to compile a BIM Execution Plan in response to an appointing party's Exchange Information Requirements. This one-day workshop will go through the critical areas required to develop the BEP for a tender response. The workshop will also include the requirements to assess the task teams' capability and capacity, development of a mobilisation plan and the delivery team's risk registers. The development of Task Information Delivery Plans (TIDP) and a Master Information Delivery Plan (MIDP) will be covered as part of the course.

Course Format: The course throughout the day will discuss and review all aspects of the BIM Execution Plan documentation by reviewing examples. All content is BS EN ISO19650-2:2018 aligned.
